Licensure and Certification Information

Educational institutions are required by law to inform students about whether or not the education they receive at FSCJ will be sufficient to sit for licensure or certification exams in each state. The information below lists each FSCJ program that could lead to licensure or certification, and **which states accept the FSCJ program to sit for exams**. It is important to note, however, that licensure and certification requirements in some states may require more than just the appropriate education. For example, some states require experience before sitting for exams, additional training or coursework obtained in their state specifically, or additional state exams. It is important to find out all the requirements needed to obtain licensure or certification in the state to which you wish to relocate.
