

Emergency Medical Technician (T.C.)

Program Requirements

To meet the minimum requirements for consideration for acceptance to the Emergency Medical Technician program, students must:

- 1. Complete an application for Florida State College at Jacksonville with online Emergency Medical Technician as the Program of Study.
- 2. Submit official non-FSCJ transcripts to the College prior to the review deadline.

Additional Admissions Information

- 1. Preference is given to students who have successfully completed the college general education requirement for math.
- 2. Students required to take MAT 0028 must enroll in the course concurrently with EMT courses.
- 3. Applicants must have an overall 2.0 GPA or higher.

Competitive Review Process

Students are ready for review upon completion of all admission criteria. The ranking rubric is included below. Please note that the admission process is highly competitive.

Students will be notified through their FSCJ Student email of their admissions status 6 weeks following the review deadline. Information concerning a student's admissions status will not be given via telephone.
