



Paramedic Technical Certificate (T.C.)

Program Requirements

To meet the minimum requirements for consideration for acceptance to the Paramedic Technical Certificate program, students must:

1. Complete an application for Florida State College at Jacksonville with Paramedic as the Program of Study.
2. Submit official non-FSCJ transcripts to the College prior to the application deadline date.
3. Submit active EMT license prior to the review deadline.

Per 401.2701(1)(b) 2. F.S.: Paramedic programs must be available only to Florida-certified emergency medical technicians or an emergency medical technician applicant who will obtain Florida certification prior to completion of phase one of the paramedic program.
