About the Program

The Associate in Science (A.S.) Degree in Emergency Medical Services (E.M.S.) advances emergency medical services through education.

Program Requirements

The **application deadlines** are May 15 for Fall Term, September 15 for Spring Term, and February 15 for Summer Term.
