

The Career Certificate (C.C.) in Facials Specialty provides a theoretical and practical hands-on approach to learning all aspects of facial specialty including facial treatments, sanitation/safety methods and procedures, facial makeup/application, hair removal, and operation of skin care machines.

This program is for those students seeking an esthetics certificate. A certificate of completion enables students to qualify for a state esthetics license. Day and evening classes start each fall, spring and summer based on interest.
