About the Program

The Career Certificate (C.C.) in Medical Assisting prepares students for a career in the multi-skilled field of medical assisting which includes instruction in the performance of basic clerical/medical office duties and clinical skills.

Students will attain the knowledge and skills needed for such career options as Administrative and clinical assisting in primary and specialized medical facilities, Phlebotomy technician, and EKG technician.

This program requires **1300 contact/clock hours** that must be completed and documented. Students should also understand and accept the attendance requirements prior to enrolling in this career certificate program. This program has the option of day classes, lasting 12 months, or evening classes, lasting 14 months. This program **is eligible** for financial aid.
