

About the Program

The Career Certificate (C.C.) in Firefighter fully prepares students for certification and employment as a firefighter in the state of Florida.

This program requires **492 contact/clock hours** that must be completed and documented. Students should also understand and accept the attendance requirements prior to enrolling in this career certificate program. This program **is not eligible** for financial aid.

Program Requirements

This is a Limited Access Program.

Students must follow the **application procedure** and fulfill the program requirements outlined in the College Catalog.

Important for You to Know

This academic roadmap does not include career certificate graduation requirements.

Students **must have earned** an EMT or Paramedic certification through the National Registry prior to starting FFP 0030.

This program is offered for full-time enrollment.

Sample Roadmap

Prior to enrolling in classes, students are strongly encouraged to **meet** with an advisor to develop an individual academic plan.

Note: Students may start FFP 0030 with a passing EMT grade but must have earned an EMT or Paramedic certification through the National Registry prior to starting FFP 0031. **Students who hold an EMT or NREMT license** will be given enrollment preference into FFP 0030.
